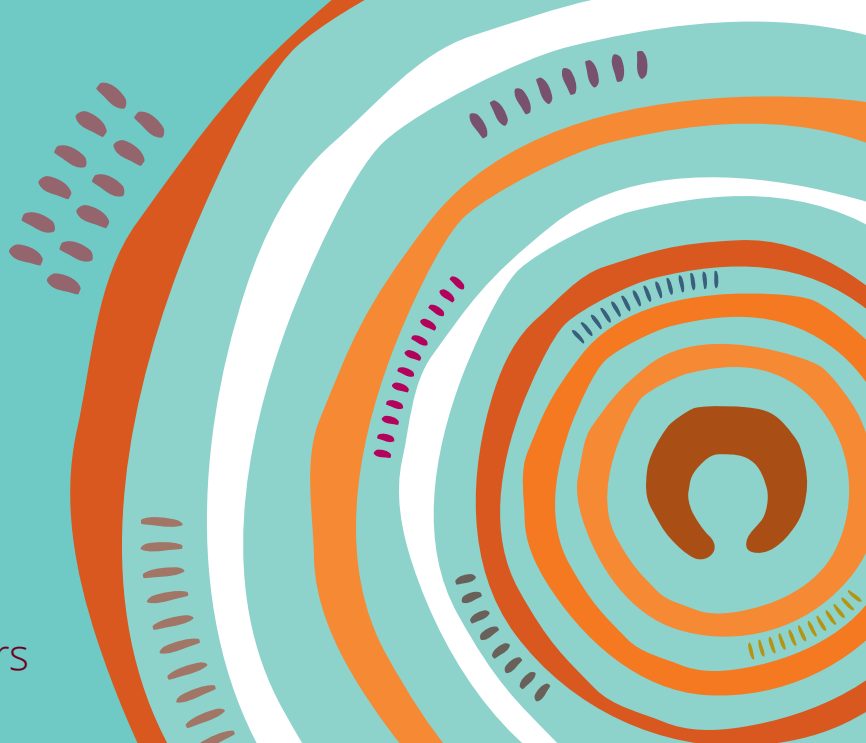


Immunisation Training
