Wednesday 22 July, 12.00 - 12:30pm AWST	Len Wayne Culbong from Peer Based Harm Reduction will present a Bite on The Deadly Peer Mob Project: Len is an Aboriginal Community Development and Peer Education Worker and works on the Deadly Peer Mob (DPM) project. DPM project supports First Nations people who inject drugs to access healthcare at PBHR, including BBV and STI screening with their nurse or Hep C case worker. First Nations volunteer peer educators connect with friends, family, and other First Nations people in the community who inject drugs, have harm reduction yarns and encourage them to access healthcare services. Monday 3 August, 12.00 - 12:30pm AWST	Claudia Bedford and Jordan Amos from Youth Educating Peers Project will present a Bite on relevant youth research findings: The YEP Project is a peer project that provides advocacy and education on SHBBV topics for young people in WA.
