- **Up to a maximum of 10 Services per calendar year for EITHER a 715 Health Assessment OR GPCCMP/Review**
- requires referral from GP and the service is recommended within the patient's plan (may specify the number of services).
- must be at least 20 mins.
- Provider provides written report back to referring Doctor on first and last visit, generally includes any assessments carried out, treatment/support provided and advice regarding future management.
- Referral valid for 18 months from the date of first service provided.

Examples of AHW/AHP Allied Health Services could include – clinical services, social and emotional support, advocacy, cultural brokerage, health promotion and education, helping patients to better understand their health condition/s, medications, management and treatment.
